- The President's Report was given by Kelly Rhinehart, President




Greater Chautauqua FCU Financial Summary as of 12/31/2023.

The Credit Union closed out the year with

- 9591 in Total Members!
- \$80.8 million in Shares & Deposits!
- \$39.5 million in Loans!
- \$91.6 million in Assets!

- Earned \$4.9 million from Loans, Investments, and Fees
- Operating Expenses totaled approximately \$3.3 million
- \$133,900 was expensed out to cover Loan Losses
- GCFCU paid out \$618,237 to our members in Dividends

After all expenses and dividends were paid, our net income resulted in \$816,270



The pie chart above shows the impact member borrowing has on the credit union's income. Loans account for 45% of our total income which is then returned to our members in the form of lower loan rates, dividends on savings, and outstanding products and services! The credit union continues to provide a safe, convenient place to save and borrow with competitive rates and personal service suited toward your specific needs.


